

## ***NORTH ANDOVER SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION***

Since 1963, the North Andover Scholarship Foundation has awarded scholarships to worthy North Andover graduating seniors. For the past several years, the total of these awards has averaged nearly \$35,000 per year. Last year, the Foundation awarded \$33,200 in scholarships, with many in the \$1,000-\$3000 range.

Some of our scholarships are based on need; others are awarded based on a student's academic achievement and/or service to the school and community, and some are awarded based on a combination of all these factors.

#### **Instruction Sheet**

1. The application for a scholarship:
  - a. Must be written with black ink or typed.
  - b. Must include a copy of the students Common Application Form, including the essay.
2. **Neatness counts!**
3. Your test scores and transcript must be attached to the application package before it is returned to your Guidance Department. The application package must be **returned to your Guidance Department no later than March 27, 2009.**

### **FINANCIAL INFORMATION**

The scholarship application issued by the Scholarship Foundation does not include any questions relative to financial background of the student/family. If you wish your application to be considered on the basis of need, in addition to merit and academic achievement, you must attach **Page 1 of the Student Aid Report** you received in response to completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Page 1 indicates the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
