

NORTH ANDOVER SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

Since 1963, the North Andover Scholarship Foundation has awarded scholarships to worthy North Andover graduating seniors. For the past several years, the total of these awards has averaged nearly \$35,000 per year. Last year, the Foundation awarded \$33,700 in scholarships, with many in the \$1,000-\$3000 range.

Some of our scholarships are based on need; others are awarded based on a student's academic achievement and/or service to the school and community, and some are awarded based on a combination of all these factors.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Instruction Sheet

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS AND THE ENTIRE APPLICATION BEFORE FILLING OUT FORMS. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY DISQUALIFY YOUR APPLICATION

1. The application for a scholarship:
 - a. Must be written with black ink or typed.
 - b. Must include a copy of the students Common Application Form, including the essay.
2. **Neatness counts!**
3. Your test scores and transcript must be attached to the application package before it is returned to your Guidance Department. The package needs to be in the hands of the NASF committee no later than April 9, 2010, therefore, the application package should be **returned to your Guidance Department no later than March 26, 2010.**

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The scholarship application issued by the Scholarship Foundation does not include any questions relative to financial background of the student/family. If you wish your application to be considered on the basis of need, in addition to merit and academic achievement, you must attach **Page 1 of the Student Aid Report** you received in response to completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Page 1 indicates the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
